READING BEGINS AT HOME

Did you know that 50 percent of intellectual development takes place between birth and four years of age?

That means that parents and caregivers are important teachers. You provide the foundation of your child's learning skills right within your own home.

You can shape the course of your child's educational future by the quality of learning experiences you provide before he or she ever goes to school.

Here are five watchwords designed to help you make the most of your child's early learning experiences:

1. **Listen** to your child. Pay attention to what he or she is saying. Call attention to sounds. Listening and attaching meaning to sounds are essential skills that must be acquired before a child can read or succeed in a classroom environment.

2. **Talk** with your child. Direct conversation to your child from infancy. Help your child learn to distinguish sounds and imitate them.
3. **Read** to your child every day. Make reading seem enjoyable. Then it will be a skill he or she will want to acquire.
4. **Move** with your child. Help your child roll over, crawl, stand and walk. This develops muscle control.
5. **Interact** with your child. Help your child learn that he or she is a part of a family group. Include your child in planning family activities. Give encouragement and praise when it is merited.

Also, control your child's television viewing. Search out better TV programs for children and share them with your child. Talk about the programs you watch. Correct any misconceptions that may have developed.



ACTIVITIES FOR CHILDREN

Valentine Hearts Flower



Children can make a beautiful valentine hearts flower for someone special.

Supplies needed:

- ◆ Red and green construction paper)
- ◆ Crayons or markers
- ◆ Scissors
- ◆ Glue or glue stick

Have children cut six paper hearts of varying sizes. Using the picture as a guide assemble the hearts on a background piece of paper with a green stem, gluing each in special, to create a very special Valentine Hearts Flower.

Rainbow Streamers



Make a handheld rainbow that you can use while putting on your own St. Patrick's Day parade or while dancing a jig.

Supplies needed:

- * Red, orange, yellow, green, blue, and purple crepe paper streamer
- * A paper plate for each child
- * Scissors
- * Stapler

Cut the center out of a paper plate. Cut long pieces of red, orange, yellow, green, blue, and purple crepe paper streamers. Each streamer should be about two to three feet long. Staple a rainbow of streamers onto the paper plate. You now have a Rainbow Streamer to help you celebrate St. Patrick's Day.

Remembering Martin Luther King, Jr.

On January 19, the nation will pause to remember a civil rights hero with a national holiday. The Rev. Martin Luther King Jr. was one of the most influential and respected civil rights leaders of the 1950's and 60's. King inspired the world and helped bring about laws that ensure fairness and equality for all Americans. A firm supporter of bringing about change with nonviolent protest, King's own life ended violently when he was shot on April 4, 1968. **In the Spirit of King's Dream:** All across the country, people will remember King's efforts and honor his legacy. In addition to public ceremonies and commemorative marches, thousands will participate in service projects. Throughout his life, King advocated lifting up the less fortunate and empowering the voiceless by attending to their basic needs: providing food and shelter and teaching them to read. CAREGIVER-CHILD ACTIVITIES: 0 - 3 YEARS OF AGE

Here are some fun activities that you as a caregiver can use to encourage bonding and learning with children from birth to 3 years of age. These activities are fun, inexpensive, and often the items are found around your house and promote early learning. Give them a try!

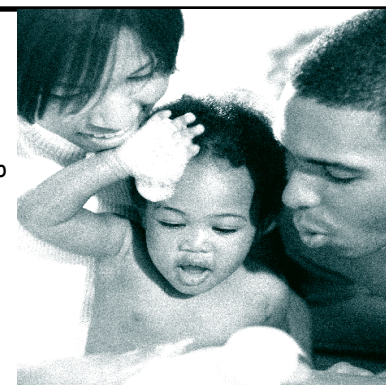
Birth to 12 Months

- ◆ **So Big!** Play "So Big." Ask: "How big is the baby?" Then lift his arms up into the air and say: "Sooooo big!" Babies love this game and will eventually learn to lift their arms in response to your question.
- ◆ **Sound It Out.** Gather several different objects that make distinct noises. Jingle, tap, or shake each one for the baby. If she reaches out to grasp one of the instruments, let her hold it and explore it with her hands. Sensory games like this enhances babies' tactile awareness and listening skills. Grasping objects encourage fine (small) muscle development.
- ◆ **Please Touch.** Cut 3x3 inch squares of fabrics (such as lace) and papers (such as sandpaper) with different colors and textures. Glue each square onto a sturdy piece of paper or posterboard. Let the babies touch each card and explore the texture with their hands. Do they want to hold the cards themselves? Reaching and grasping behaviors show you that babies are now beginning to act on their desires.
- ◆ **Wrap It Up.** Wrap a ball of waxed paper in a scarf and tie it up. Let the children reach for it, grasp it, squeeze and crinkle it. Watch their faces to see if they are interested or surprised by the sounds the package makes. You can put into words what you see on their faces, "Wow! It crinkles and crackles. What's inside?" Games like this encourage tactile awareness, reaching, grasping and language development.

12 to 24 Months

- ◆ **Ramp-n-Roll.** Make a low ramp by balancing a cutting board on a small stack of books. Show toddlers how to roll a ball or toy car down this ramp. Can they do it too? Try rolling a beach ball down a longer ramp (an ironing board propped on a coffee table, stair-step or pile of books). With your help, can they do this too? Activities like these help children develop a sense of confidence and self-efficacy (the notion that "I can do it!"). They also build torso control and upper body strength.
- ◆ **Cruising Curiosity.** Place a collection of fun and interesting objects (feathers, spoons, whisk, balls,

etc.) on top of a low table that is safe for the child to stand next to and cruise around. Encourage him to pull up on the table and check out the toys. Spot him carefully as he makes his way around the table to explore each of the objects you've placed there. Activities like this promote muscle strength and dynamic balance.



- ◆ **Basket-Stroll.** Help children practice walking by filling a laundry basket with toys and then letting them stand and push it (while you stand on the other side and make sure the basket remains steady and doesn't go too fast). This game will help toddlers develop muscle strength and balance. Be sure to watch what the child is communicating as he plays-if he looks like he is unsure of himself, slow things down and let him take his time.

24-36 Months

- ◆ **River Walk.** Cut large circles, squares and triangles from colored paper and lay them randomly on the floor (you might want to tape them so they don't slide). Tell the children that you need to get from one point to another without stepping on the floor. You can only step on the shapes. See how they respond to this challenge. They may step on the floor in the beginning, but will figure it out eventually. Later, you can make it more challenging by only stepping on red pieces or only on circles. Games like this help children develop problem-solving skills and also build their understanding of shapes and colors.
- ◆ **Lighty Light.** Find a flashlight with an easy on/off button for "light play" with your toddlers. Dim the room lights and shine a beam on the walls and ceiling, on the children's arms and legs, on your face. Then let the children make the light "dance". After a while, they will be delighted to figure out that they are controlling where the light goes!
- ◆ **Tunnel Vision.** Make a box tunnel by opening both ends of 3 to 5 moving boxes and lining them up in a row. You can vary the game by adding turns to the tunnel with more boxes, substituting boxes of smaller and smaller sizes (until the last one is just small enough to wiggle through), or by adding a "door" by hanging a blanket over one end. This helps children develop motor planning (sequencing one's movements to reach a goal), coordination and spatial awareness skills.
